- Provide a coordinated "umbrella" structure and coordinate activities that keep the project on task
- Recruit volunteers with an emphasis on seniors (55+)
- Schedule class time in the Garden for the participating schools and programs
- Record-keep for the project: budget, photo-taking, project activities, etc.
- Coordinate the maintenance of garden structure
- Schedule topic specific sessions that teachers may bring a class to
- The Coordinator will report to the Steering Committee and the Seniors Network
- Attend monthly Steering Committee meetings and take notes
