Eligible Programs:

First Book Canada provides brand new, age-appropriate books and educational resources to programs serving children from low-income families. **Eligible programs must serve at least 70% children from low-income families** to register.

Registering with First Book Canada:

Program administrators and teachers are encouraged to register with First Book Canada online - <http://www.firstbookcanada.org/receive-books>. Registration takes minutes to complete and once registered programs receive immediate confirmation.

Tip: Recipient groups receive monthly newsletters and emails regarding National Book Banks book distributions prompting you to apply for books – if you opt to unsubscribe from our newsletter, you will no longer receive news about National Book Banks.

Once Registered:

First Book Canada distributes free books through the National Book Bank. To receive books, recipient groups must submit an application when prompted. Groups can opt to have their books shipped for a fee or can pick them up for free.

We only grant full carton quantities and do not break down boxes of books. To secure individual titles, it is recommended groups take advantage of the First Book Canada Marketplace where you can buy brand new books at 50%-90% below retail prices. <http://www.fbmpcanada.org/>
